#### NOTES RE CATRON SEAT

1. The NM state legislature – as per the authorization of Article VI, Section 10, of the NM Constitution – added two additional supreme court justice seats to the original three seats. The two new justices, Charles C. Catron, Republican, son of NM politico Thomas B. Catron (Roberts, 194), and John F. Simms, Sr., Democrat, father of a future NM governor, John F. Simms, Jr., on March 15, 1929 (Roberts, 196), and took office on April 19, 1929 (NM Blue Book 1947-48, 59).
2. Sadler retired on May 15, 1959 (NMR 65: 1958-59, v).
3. Moise was appointed to the Sadler vacancy by Governor John Burroughs on May 16, 1959 (Roberts, 297), and took office on the same date (NMR 65: 1958-59, v).
4. Moise retired on March 31, 1970 (NMR 81: 1969-70, v).
5. McKenna was appointed to the Moise vacancy by David F. Cargo on April 6, 1970 (Roberts, 319), and took office on the same date (NMR 81: 1969-70, v).
6. Oman retired on March 31, 1977 (NMR 90: 1976-77, v).
7. Federici was appointed to the Oman vacancy by Governor Jerry Apodaca on April 15, 1977 (NMR 90: 1976-77, v).
8. Scarborough resigned on July 5, 1989 (NMR 108: 1988-89, v).
9. Montgomery was appointed to the Scarborough vacancy by Governor Gary Carruthers on September 5, 1989 (NMR 108: 1988-89, v).
10. Montgomery retired on October 27, 1994 (NMR 117: 1992-94, v).
11. Minzner was appointed by Governor Bruce King to the Montgomery vacancy, effective December 2, 1994 (NMR 118: 1992-94, v). Won retention in November 2002 election. (SCR) Died in office August 31, 2007. (SCR)
12. Daniels was appointed by Governor Bill Richardson to the Minzner vacancy, effective November 5, 2007 (NMR 142, 2007, v).
