CHECKLIST FOR APPLICATION AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED UNDER RULE 15-301.1 FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEE LIMITED LAW LICENSE

- 1. Application for a Limited License (sample attached).
- 2. A letter from the governmental agency authority certifying applicant's employment with a qualifying governmental entity.
- 3. Original certificate of good standing from all states in which admitted. All certificates of good standing must be issued and dated within thirty (30) days of the date the limited law license application is submitted to the Supreme Court.
- 4. A certificate (statement) by the applicant that the applicant (1) has read and is familiar with the New Mexico Rules of Professional Conduct, the Creed of Professionalism of the State Bar of New Mexico, and rules of the Supreme Court of New Mexico and New Mexico statutes relating to the conduct of attorneys; and (2) has applied for a character and fitness investigation with the New Mexico Board of Bar Examiners in conformance with Rules 15-104(A) and (C) and 15-301 NMRA.
- 5. Proof of age (must be 18 years of age). A statement by the applicant that they are 18 years of age or more is satisfactory. (This may be included in the certificate referenced in paragraph 4 above.)
- 6. Proof of graduation from law school. A statement by the applicant containing the name of the law school and whether it is ABA accredited is satisfactory. (This may be included in the certificate referenced in paragraph 4 above.)
 - If applicant graduated from a non-ABA accredited law school, the practice requirement must be certified on a document (may be a certificate of good standing) that states from what date to what date the applicant has been an active member. Also, the applicant must set forth the applicant's employment history so the N.M. Supreme Court can determine if the applicant practiced for at least four (4) of the six (6) years immediately preceding the application.
- 7. \$125.00 docket fee check or money order payable to Supreme Court of New Mexico.
- 8. A \$250.00 fee must be paid directly to the Board of Bar Examiners when submitting the application for a character and fitness investigation under Rule 15-301.1(C)(3).
