WHEREAS, this matter having come before the Court upon recommendation to amend certain deadlines for the bar dues and minimum continuing legal education (MCLE) delinquencies and administrative suspension processes in light of the ongoing impact on workflow procedures during the COVID-19 public health emergency, and the Court having considered the recommendation and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Judith K. Nakamura, Justice Barbara J. Vigil, Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, and Justice David K. Thomson concurring;

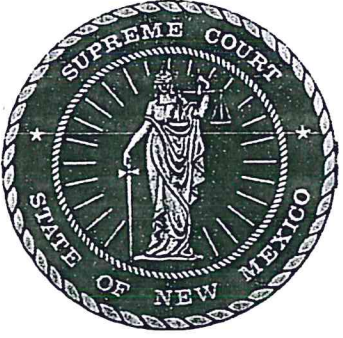
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the bar dues delinquency certification for the 2020 bar dues cycle from the Executive Director of the State Bar of New Mexico to the Clerk of the Supreme Court under Rule 24-102(D) NMRA shall be due on May 1, 2020; and the show cause period for orders to show cause issued by the Clerk of the Supreme Court under Rule 24-102(D) shall be expanded to thirty (30) days;

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
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the date for imposing the two hundred fifty dollar (\$250.00) sanction under Rule 18-301(H)(2) NMRA for noncompliance with MCLE requirements shall be extended to May 1, 2020, and the date for paying sanctions imposed under Rule 18-301(H)(2) NMRA shall be extended to May 31, 2020; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the MCLE delinquency certification for the 2019 compliance year to be submitted to the Clerk of the Supreme Court under Rule 18-301(F) NMRA shall be due on June 1, 2020; and the show cause period for orders to show cause issued by the Clerk of the Supreme Court under Rule 18-301(G) NMRA shall be expanded to thirty (30) days.
