ORDER

WHEREAS, this Court recognizing the need to provide additional time to pay certain fines and fees assessed in district, metropolitan, magistrate, and municipal court cases in light of the ongoing COVID-19 public health emergency and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Judith K. Nakamura, Justice Barbara J. Vigil, Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, and Justice David K. Thomson concurring;

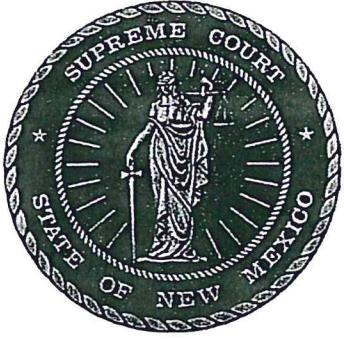
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that any individual ordered to pay fines or fees in a case in the district, metropolitan, magistrate, or municipal court that are due between May 30, 2020, and June 30, 2020, shall be granted an additional thirty (30) days from the original due date to pay said fines and fees; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order does not enlarge the additional


