8 **ORDER**

9 WHEREAS, on May 3, 2019, this Court issued Order No. 19-8500-006 to
10 define the terms and conditions upon which former New Mexico district judges,
11 Court of Appeals judges, and Supreme Court justices may attend the annual
12 Judicial Conclave, and the Court wishing to revise those terms and conditions and
13 being sufficiently advised; Chief Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice Barbara J. Vigil,
14 Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice David K. Thomson, and Justice Julie J. Vargas
15 concurring;

16 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that former New Mexico district
17 judges, Court of Appeals judges, and Supreme Court justices who meet the
18 following requirements may attend the annual Judicial Conclave:

- 19 1. The former judge or justice shall be retired, or eligible to retire, under
20 the Judicial Retirement Act or the Magistrate Retirement Act; and

22 2. The former judge or justice shall not be engaged in the representation
23 of clients in legal matters;

1 IT FURTHER ORDERED that any former judge or justice meeting the
2 eligibility requirements set forth in this order may attend the annual Judicial
3 Conclave without charge;


4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a former judge or justice meeting the
5 eligibility requirements set forth in this order for attending the Judicial Conclave
6 may do so without charge if the former judge or justice is willing to serve as a
7 judge pro tempore or, if not willing to serve as a judge pro tempore, does not
8 receive remuneration for providing alternative dispute resolution services; and

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Supreme Court Order No. 19-8500-007 is
10 WITHDRAWN.
