8 **ORDER**

9 WHEREAS, on October 14, 1988, this Court issued Order No. 8000 Misc.
10 to establish the compensation rate for district judges pro tempore, and the Court
11 wishing to update and clarify the compensation practices for district judges pro
12 tempore and being sufficiently advised; Chief Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice
13 Barbara J. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice David K. Thomson, and
14 Justice Julie J. Vargas concurring;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that any retired judge or justice
16 appointed to serve as a district judge pro tempore shall be compensated at the
17 hourly rate of ninety-seven dollars and forty-one cents (\$97.41) until further order
18 of the Court;

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that district judges pro tempore may be
20 reimbursed for the travel expenses related to their service as a judge pro tempore in
21 accordance with the Per Diem and Mileage Act;

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IT FURTHER ORDERED that the compensation and reimbursement requirements in this order shall govern payments from the funds appropriated to the Judges Pro Tempore Fund or from any other source;

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the terms of this order shall be effective for all district judges pro tempore appointed to preside in a case on or after July 1, 2021; and

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
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Supreme Court Order No. 8000 Misc., dated October 14, 1988, is WITHDRAWN.
