8 **ORDER**

9 WHEREAS, on May 3, 2019, this Court issued Order No. 19-8500-007 to
10 define the terms and conditions upon which former New Mexico district judges,
11 Court of Appeals judges, and Supreme Court justices may attend the annual
12 Judicial Conclave;

13 WHEREAS, the Court having revised those terms and conditions on June
14 28, 2021 by Order No. 21-8500-012, and having withdrawn Order No. 19-8500-
15 007; and the Court now wishing to revise the terms and conditions set forth in
16 Order No. 21-8500-012, and being sufficiently advised; Chief Justice Michael E.
17 Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice David K. Thomson, Justice Julie J.
18 Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora concurring;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that former New Mexico district
20 judges, Court of Appeals judges, and Supreme Court justices who meet the
21 following requirements may attend the annual Judicial Conclave:

1. The former judge or justice shall be retired, or eligible to retire, under the Judicial Retirement Act or the Magistrate Retirement Act; and
2. The former judge or justice shall not be engaged in the representation of clients in legal matters for a fee;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any former judge or justice meeting the eligibility requirements set forth in this order may attend the annual Judicial Conclave without charge;


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a former judge or justice meeting the eligibility requirements set forth in this order for attending the Judicial Conclave may do so without charge if the former judge or justice is willing to serve as a judge pro tempore or, if not willing to serve as a judge pro tempore, does not receive remuneration for providing alternative dispute resolution services; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Supreme Court Order No. 21-8500-012 is WITHDRAWN.
