



1           WHEREAS, it is impracticable for judges to obtain permission from the  
2 warrant-issuing judge, consistent with Rule 6-105(A) NMRA, within the time  
3 allocated for the event; and


4           WHEREAS, the Court having considered the foregoing and being sufficiently  
5 advised, Chief Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice David K.  
6 Thomson, Justice Julie J. Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora concurring;


7           NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Rule 6-105(A) NMRA shall be  
8 suspended for the sole purpose of permitting the above-named magistrate judges to  
9 preside over and enter orders in cases in which a party has an outstanding warrant  
10 and surrenders at the safe surrender event at the San Juan County Magistrate Court  
11 in Aztec, New Mexico, on August 11, 2023, or August 12, 2023.
