

1 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that for all cases pending in this
2 Court and the Court of Appeals in which a party is represented by the LOPD's
3 Appellate Division, the briefing deadlines are hereby automatically tolled for a
4 period of four (4) weeks or until access to the LOPD network client files is restored,
5 whichever occurs first;

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that after the four (4) week period set forth
7 above or upon restoration of access to the LOPD network, there shall be an automatic
8 extension to all briefing deadlines for the number of days that attorneys were unable
9 to access the LOPD network client files;

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the tolling provision set forth above shall
11 not apply to deadlines for the filing of petitions for writ of certiorari, to any case
12 filed under Rule 12-204 NMRA, and to any case set to be submitted in this Court's
13 2024–2025 term, unless otherwise ordered by the Court;

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the tolling provision shall not apply to cases
15 in which a party is represented by LOPD contract counsel;

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any request for an accommodation with
17 regard to the record proper, transcripts, exhibits, or any other case material may be
18 requested by the LOPD and may be granted at the discretion of the respective Clerk's
19 Office and in accordance with any directives from JID; and

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court of Appeals and Supreme Court
2 may implement processes, whether formally or informally, with regard to filing and
3 access to case materials at the discretion of the respective Clerk's Office until this
4 matter is resolved.
