8 WHEREAS, Rule LR11-302 NMRA was withdrawn effective immediately
9 by Supreme Court Order No. S-1-RCR-2024-00067;

10 WHEREAS, the Eleventh Judicial District has been utilizing statewide Rule
11 5-805 NMRA to govern its technical violations since the withdrawal of LR11-302
12 NMRA;

13 WHEREAS, the Eleventh Judicial District shall submit a new technical
14 violation program for the Court's consideration no later than October 31, 2024; and

15 WHEREAS, the Court having considered the recommendation and being
16 sufficiently advised, Chief Justice David K. Thomson, Justice Michael E. Vigil,
17 Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice Julie J. Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora
18 concurring;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that until the Court approves a
20 technical violation program proposed by Eleventh Judicial District, the District shall
21 operate under Rule LR2-307 NMRA; and

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Eleventh Judicial District shall
2 implement the technical violation program under Rule LR2-307 NMRA effective
3 immediately;

4 IT IS SO ORDERED.
