2 approval of the ordinance"; and

3 WHEREAS, pursuant to and in compliance with Section 35-14-4, the Board  
4 of Trustees of the Village of Williamsburg adopted a resolution establishing a  
5 committee to review the proposed transition and that committee recommended the  
6 Village proceed with the transfer of jurisdiction;

7 WHEREAS, also pursuant to and in compliance with Section 35-14-4, the  
8 Village of Williamsburg adopted Ordinance 135, designating the Truth or  
9 Consequences Magistrate Court as the court having jurisdiction over its municipal  
10 ordinances, contingent upon the approval of the Supreme Court; and

11 WHEREAS, the Court having considered the foregoing and being sufficiently  
12 advised, Chief Justice David K. Thomson, Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C.  
13 Shannon Bacon, Justice Julie J. Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora concurring;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Ordinance 135 is APPROVED  
15 and the Village of Williamsburg Municipal Court's jurisdiction is hereby transferred  
16 to the Truth or Consequences Magistrate Court in Sierra County, effective upon the  
17 expiration of municipal Judge Carol Woods' term of office; and


1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Office of the Courts  
2 shall assist the Village of Williamsburg Municipal Court and the Truth or  
3 Consequences Magistrate Court with the transfer of jurisdiction.

4 IT IS SO ORDERED.
