

1 **10-346. Judicial reviews.**

2 If a judgment has been filed finding a child to be neglected or abused, within sixty (60)
3 days after the date the judgment was filed, the court shall review the treatment plan approved by
4 the court. At least once every six (6) months thereafter, the court shall review the department’s
5 progress in implementing the court’s orders. The department shall request a date for each judicial
6 review and give notice as required by law. Not less than five (5) days before a judicial review
7 hearing, the department shall prepare and serve on each party a judicial review hearing report. The
8 report shall set forth any changes to the disposition plan.
