

1 **2-101. Scope and title.**

2 A. **Scope.** These rules shall govern the civil procedure in all magistrate courts. These
3 rules shall be subject to the provisions of Rule 23-114 NMRA, the rule governing free process for
4 civil cases.

5 B. **Construction.** These rules shall be liberally construed to secure the just, speedy
6 and inexpensive determination of every magistrate court action. They shall not be construed to
7 extend or limit the jurisdiction of any court, or to abridge, enlarge or modify the substantive rights
8 of any litigant.

9 C. **Title.** These rules shall be known as the Rules of Civil Procedure for the Magistrate
10 Courts.

11 D. **Citation form.** These rules shall be cited by set and rule numbers in accordance
12 with Rule 23-112 NMRA, as in [~~NMRA,~~]Rule 2- ____ NMRA.
