5 offense, and each form must be typed on a separate page.

6 2. Use this provision and insert the name of each defendant when there are multiple  
7 defendants.

8 3. Insert the name of the offense; do not leave blank for the jury to complete.

9 4. Insert the count number, if any; do not leave blank for the jury to complete.

10 5. This form is appropriate for lesser included offenses. *See* UJI 14-6012 NMRA.

11 6. Insert the appropriate bracketed phrase. If multiple alternatives are at issue, a  
12 separate verdict form or verdict finding should be used for each alternative.

13 a. Use the first alternative, “with the use of a firearm,” for all noncapital felony  
14 crimes committed on or before June 30, 2020, and for crimes committed on or after May 18, 2022,  
15 if the firearm was used in the commission of a drug transaction, an aggravated burglary under  
16 Section 30-16-4 NMSA 1978, or a serious violent offense under Section 33-2-34(L)(4)(a) through  
17 (n) NMSA 1978.

18 b. The second alternative, “while brandishing a firearm,” may be used for all  
19 noncapital felony crimes committed on or after July 1, 2020.

20 c. The third alternative, “while discharging a firearm,” may be used for all  
21 noncapital felony crimes committed on or after May 18, 2022.
