NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the provisional amendment of Rules 5-602.1, 5-602.2, 5-602.3, 6-507.1, 7-506, and 8-507.1 NMRA and Form 9-514 NMRA is APPROVED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Rule 7-507.1 NMRA is SUSPENDED until further order of this Court;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced amendments shall be effective September 30, 2025; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and directed to provide notice of the above-referenced amendments on the Supreme Court's public website and in the *Bar Bulletin* and to publish the amendments in the *New Mexico Rules Annotated*.
