22 WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration to provisionally amend
23 Rules 5-602.1, 5-602.2, and 5-602.3 NMRA of the Rules of Criminal Procedure for
24 the District Courts, Rule 6-507.1 NMRA of the Rules of Criminal Procedure for the
25 Magistrate Courts, Rule 7-506 NMRA of the Rules of Criminal Procedure for the
26 Metropolitan Courts, Rule 8-507.1 NMRA of the Rules of Procedure for the
27 Municipal Courts, and Form 9-514 NMRA of the Criminal Forms, and to suspend
28 Rule 7-507.1 NMRA of the Rules of Criminal Procedure for the Metropolitan

1 Courts, and the Court having considered the foregoing and being sufficiently
2 advised, Chief Justice David K. Thomson, Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C.
3 Shannon Bacon, Justice Julie J. Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora concurring;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the provisional amendment of
5 Rules 5-602.1, 5-602.2, 5-602.3, 6-507.1, 7-506, and 8-507.1 NMRA and Form 9-
6 514 NMRA is APPROVED;

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Rule 7-507.1 NMRA is SUSPENDED until
8 further order of this Court;


9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced amendments shall be
