WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration to reinstate and provisionally amend Rule 7-507.1 NMRA in light of recent amendments to NMSA 1978, Section 31-9-1 (2025), which allow the Bernalillo County Metropolitan Court (metropolitan court) to determine whether a defendant is competent to stand trial in a criminal case:

WHEREAS, the amendments to Section 31-9-1 took effect on October 3, 2025;

WHEREAS, Rule 7-507.1, which sets forth the procedure for resolving whether a defendant is competent to stand trial in a criminal case in the metropolitan court, was suspended by Supreme Court Order Nos. S-1-AO-2025-00014 and S-1-RCR-2025-00143;

WHEREAS, Supreme Court Order No. S-1-AO-2025-00014 was later amended on August 19, 2025, and September 30, 2025, respectively;
