

1 **3-708. [Tape] Audio recordings of proceedings.**

2 A. **[Taping] Audio record of proceedings.** Every civil proceeding in the
3 metropolitan court shall be [tape] audio recorded [if requested by a party]. [The summons shall
4 contain notice of the right to request a taped record of the proceedings.]

5 B. **Preservation of [taped] audio record.** [Tapes containing the] The audio record of
6 proceedings shall be preserved for ninety (90) days after the entry of a final order in the
7 proceedings. Any party desiring to preserve the tapes for a longer period of time may, within eighty
8 (80) days after the filing of the final order, file a request to preserve the [tapes] audio record
9 containing the transcript of proceedings.
