24-113. Certificates of good standing.

All members of the state bar in good standing, either on active or inactive status, may request a certificate of good standing from the Supreme Court for a fee of \$1.00. A request shall be submitted in the manner prescribed by the Supreme Court Clerk. Unless otherwise provided in the certificate, a certificate of good standing is effective for thirty (30) days from the date of its issuance.
