

1 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that new local Rules LR4-601, LR6-
2 601, and LR11-601 NMRA are ADOPTED;

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the proposed new sliding fee scales for civil
4 alternative dispute resolution programs in the Fourth, Sixth, and Eleventh Judicial
5 District Courts are APPROVED and shall be posted on the websites and inside the
6 courthouses of the respective district courts;

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced new rules and sliding
8 fee scales shall be **effective December 31, 2019**; and

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and
10 directed to give notice of the above-referenced amendments by publishing them in
11 the *Bar Bulletin* and *New Mexico Rules Annotated*.
