21                  and 5-210 NMRA of the Rules of Criminal Procedure for the District Courts,  
22                  Rules 6-108, 6-201, 6-202, and 6-206 NMRA of the Rules of Criminal Procedure  
23                  for the Magistrate Courts, Rules 7-108, 7-201, 7-202, and 7-206 NMRA of the  
24                  Rules of Criminal Procedure for the Metropolitan Courts, and Rules 8-201 and 8-  
25                  205 NMRA of the Rules of Procedure for the Municipal Courts, and the Court  
26                  having considered the recommendation and being sufficiently advised, Chief

1 Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice Barbara J. Vigil, Justice Judith K. Nakamura,  
2 Justice C. Shannon Bacon, and Justice David K. Thomson concurring;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the amendment of Rules 5-201,  
4 5-210, 6-108, 6-201, 6-202, 6-206, 7-108, 7-201, 7-202, 7-206, 8-201, and 8-205  
5 NMRA is APPROVED;


6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced amendments shall
