10 WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration upon recommendation to
11 amend the rules governing peremptory excusals, Rules 1-088.1, 2-106, 3-106, 5-106,
12 6-106, 7-106, and 10-162 NMRA, and the Court having considered the
13 recommendation and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Michael E. Vigil,
14 Justice Barbara J. Vigil, Justice Judith K. Nakamura, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, and
15 Justice David K. Thomson concurring;

16 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the amendment of Rules 1-
17 088.1, 2-106, 3-106, 5-106, 6-106, 7-106, and 10-162 NMRA is APPROVED;


18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon the lifting of the temporary
19 suspension of the exercise of peremptory excusals under Emergency Court Protocol
20 No. 3(D), Supreme Court Order No. 20-8500-025, the above-referenced
21 amendments shall be **effective for all cases pending or filed on or after December**
22 **31, 2020**; and

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and
2 directed to give notice of the above-referenced amendments by publishing them in
3 the *Bar Bulletin* and *New Mexico Rules Annotated*.
