11	WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration upon recommendation of the

14	NMRA of the Rules of Civil Procedure for the Metropolitan Courts, and the Court having

18	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the amendment of Rules 2-205 and 3-
19	205 NMRA is APPROVED;
20	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the electronic filing system in the Magistrate
21	Courts shall be implemented in three phases as follows:
22	PHASE ONE: Magistrate Courts in the Fifth Judicial District (Chaves, Eddy, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that attorneys may register for and begin using the electronic filing system on a voluntary basis in the Magistrate Courts scheduled for phase three rollout **effective July 26, 2021**;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amendment of Rule 2-205 NMRA shall be **effective September 9, 2021**, forty-five days after the rollout of the third phase, at which time electronic filing will become mandatory for all Magistrate Courts;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amendment of Rule 3-205 NMRA shall be effective March 5, 2021; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and directed to give notice of the above-referenced amendments by publishing them in the *Bar Bulletin* and *New Mexico Rules Annotated*.
