10 WHEREAS, this matter having come on for consideration by the Court upon
11 recommendation for the temporary adoption of forms to apply for writs of
12 garnishment and writs of execution in consumer debt collection cases when the
13 temporary stay of issuance of such writs under Order No. 20-8500-021 is lifted by
14 Order No. 21-8500-018, and the Court having considered the recommendation and
15 being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon
16 Bacon, Justice David K. Thomson, and Justice Julie J. Vargas concurring;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that new Forms 4-805.1 and 4-805.2
18 NMRA of the Civil Forms are ADOPTED FOR A LIMITED TIME;

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced new forms shall be
20 **effective for applications filed on or after September 1, 2021;**

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced new forms shall be
22 **withdrawn on February 1, 2022, unless otherwise ordered by this Court;** and


23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and

1 directed to give notice of the above-referenced new rules and forms by publishing
2 them in the *Bar Bulletin* and *New Mexico Rules Annotated*.
