15 WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration upon recommendation of
16 the Children’s Court Rules Committee to provisionally adopt new Rules 10-360, 10-
17 801, 10-802 NMRA; provisionally amend Rules 10-101, 10-103, 10-121, and 10-
18 345 NMRA; and provisionally adopt new Forms 10-901, 10-902, 10-903, 10-904,
19 10-905, 10-906, 10-907, and 10-908 NMRA of the Children’s Court Rules and
20 Forms, and the Court having considered the recommendation and being sufficiently
21 advised, Chief Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice David K.
22 Thomson, Justice Julie J. Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora concurring;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that new Rules 10-360, 10-801, and
24 10-802 NMRA are PROVISIONALLY ADOPTED;

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amendment of Rules 10-101, 10-103,
2 10-121, and 10-345 NMRA is PROVISIONALLY APPROVED;

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that new Forms 10-901, 10-902, 10-903, 10-
4 904, 10-905, 10-906, 10-907, and 10-908 are PROVISIONALLY ADOPTED;


5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced provisionally
6 approved new and amended rules and new forms shall be **effective November 12,**
7 **2021** and shall remain in effect **until further order of the Court;** and

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and
9 directed to give notice of the above-referenced amendments by publishing them in
10 the *Bar Bulletin* and *New Mexico Rules Annotated*.

11 IT IS SO ORDERED.
