15                                           **ORDER**

16           WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration upon recommendation of  
17 the Uniform Jury Instructions – Criminal Committee to amend Uniform Jury  
18 Instructions 14-7010, 14-7011, 14-7012, 14-7014, 14-7015, 14-7016, 14-7017, 14-  
19 7018, 14-7019, 14-7022, 14-7023, 14-7026, 14-7027, 14-7031, 14-7032, and 14-  
20 7034 NMRA and to withdraw Uniform Jury Instructions 14-7029, 14-7030, 14-  
21 7030A, and 14-7033 NMRA of the Uniform Jury Instructions – Criminal, and the  
22 Court having considered the recommendation and being sufficiently advised, Chief  
23 Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice David K. Thomson,  
24 Justice Julie J. Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora concurring;

25           NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the amendment of Uniform Jury  
26 Instructions 14-7010, 14-7011, 14-7012, 14-7014, 14-7015, 14-7016, 14-7017, 14-

1 7018, 14-7019, 14-7022, 14-7023, 14-7026, 14-7027, 14-7031, 14-7032, and 14-  
2 7034 NMRA of the Uniform Jury Instructions – Criminal is APPROVED;

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Uniform Jury Instructions 14-7029, 14-  
4 7030, 14-7030A, AND 14-7033 NMRA of the Uniform Jury Instructions – Criminal  
5 are WITHDRAWN;


6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced amendments shall be  
7 **effective for all cases pending or filed on or after December 31, 2021**; and

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and  
9 directed to provide notice of the above-referenced amendments on the Supreme  
10 Court’s public website and in the *Bar Bulletin* and to publish the amendments in the  
11 *New Mexico Rules Annotated*.
