6 ~~members shall be district court judges and two members shall be metropolitan court judges. As~~
7 ~~much as feasible, the members shall be appointed with staggered terms. The Supreme Court may~~
8 ~~also appoint a justice to serve as the Court's liaison to the committee. The director of the Judicial~~
9 ~~Education Center shall provide staff support for the committee in the performance of its duties.~~

10 ~~—— (3) — The chairperson of the committee shall be appointed by and shall serve at~~
