16 **ORDER**

17 WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration upon recommendation of
18 the Rules of Civil Procedure for State Courts Committee to provisionally adopt new
19 Rule 1-077.1 NMRA of the Rules of Civil Procedure for the District Courts and to
20 provisionally adopt new Forms 4-951, 4-952, 4-953, 4-954, 4-955, 4-956, 4-957, 4-
21 958, 4-959, 4-960, 4-960.1, 4-960.2, and 4-960.3 NMRA of the Civil Forms and to
22 amend Rules 1-004 and 1-079 NMRA of the Rules of Civil Procedure for the District
23 Courts, and the Court having considered the recommendation and being sufficiently
24 advised, Chief Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice David
25 K. Thomson, Justice Julie J. Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora concurring;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that new Rule 1-077.1 NMRA is
2 PROVISIONALLY ADOPTED;

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that new Forms 4-951, 4-952, 4-953, 4-954, 4-
4 955, 4-956, 4-957, 4-958, 4-959, 4-960, 4-960.1, 4-960.2, and 4-960.3 NMRA are
5 PROVISIONALLY ADOPTED;

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amendment of Rules 1-004 and 1-079
7 NMRA is PROVISIONALLY APPROVED;


8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced amendments shall be
9 **effective January 28, 2022**; and

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and
11 directed to provide notice of the above-referenced amendments on the Supreme
12 Court's public website and in the *Bar Bulletin* and to publish the amendments in the
13 *New Mexico Rules Annotated*.

14 IT IS SO ORDERED.
