10	WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration upon recommendation of
11	the Ad Hoc Criminal Review Committee to provisionally amend Rule 5-304 NMRA
12	of the Rules of Criminal Procedure for the District Courts to allow judicial
13	participation in settlement conferences as a means to streamline the processing of
14	criminal cases during the COVID-19 public health emergency, and the Court having
15	considered the recommendation and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice
16	Michael E. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice David K. Thomson, Justice
17	Julie J. Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora concurring;
18	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the amendment of Rule 5-304
19	NMRA is PROVISIONALLY APPROVED;
20	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced amendments shall be
21	effective for all cases pending or filed on or after January 18, 2022, and shall
22	remain in effect until further order of the Court;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and directed to provide notice of the above-referenced amendments on the Supreme Court's public website and in the *Bar Bulletin* and to publish the amendments in the *New Mexico Rules Annotated*.
