## ORDER

WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration by the Court upon recommendation to provisionally adopt new Forms 4-904A, 4-904B, 4-905A, 4905B, 4-908A, 4-908B, 4-908C, 4-908D, and 4-923A NMRA of the Civil Forms, and the Court having considered the recommendation and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice David K. Thomson, Justice Julie J. Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora concurring;

WHEREAS, the new forms are intended to implement the Eviction Prevention and Diversion Program, which will commence with a pilot project in the Ninth Judicial District on February 1, 2022, as set forth in Supreme Court Order No. 22-8500-001; and

WHEREAS, the Eviction Prevention and Diversion Program is expected to expand to all jurisdictions in the state in March 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that new Forms 4-904A, 4-904B, 4905A, 4-905B, 4-908A, 4-908B, 4-908C, 4-908D, and 4-923A NMRA are PROVISIONALLY ADOPTED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced new forms shall be effective for all cases pending or filed on or after February 1, 2022 that are subject to the Eviction Prevention and Diversion Program; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and directed to provide notice of the above-referenced amendments on the Supreme Court's public website and in the Bar Bulletin and to publish the amendments in the New Mexico Rules Annotated. IT IS SO ORDERED.
