20   NMRA of the Rules of Criminal Procedure for the Magistrate Courts, Rule 7-205  
21   NMRA of the Rules of Criminal Procedure for the Metropolitan Courts, and Rule 8-  
22   204 NMRA of the Rules of Procedure for the Municipal Courts, and the Court having  
23   considered the recommendation and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice C.  
24   Shannon Bacon, Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice David K. Thomson, Justice Julie  
25   J. Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora concurring;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the amendment of Rules 5-209,  
2 6-205, 7-205, and 8-204 NMRA is APPROVED;


3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced amendments to the
